Crestmont is our newest concept in motorhome thinking. For starters, it's a compact 23 feet in length. It features both rear- and side-bath floor plans.

New, yes. But underneath, Crestmont offers a score of proven GMC features. Like front wheel drive and tandem rear wheels with air suspension.

So, while floor plans and models may vary, one thing remains the same: GMC quality.

Quality that provides peace of mind each time you take the captain's chair.

A bonus, all windows are tinted to reduce glare.

Crestmont's living space is very comfortable. Each floor-plan features its own color coordinated upholstery, draperies and nylon carpeting.

The dinette area is designed for efficiency and comfort; the place to enjoy your meals. It also serves as a lounge area. You simply remove the table for extra legroom.

For sleeping, the dinette converts to a double bed. And, for privacy, a divider drapery easily separates the living area from the driver compartment.

There's no shortage of accommodations in Crestmont. The side-bath model features a rear bedroom with two gauchos that convert to a second double bed. A walnut-finished closet opposite the bath provides ample storage space.

Yet, underneath, Birchaven is a proven GMC MotorHome. From its sleek, aerodynamic body to its tandem rear wheels with air suspension.

All that built-in GMC know-how makes Birchaven a pleasure to drive. For increased enjoyment, all windows are tinted to reduce glare. And road noise is kept in check by a thorough application of thick foam insulation.

In Birchaven, you'll find a very comfortable environment in which to relax, sleep, dine, or just talk with



friends. Four interior colors are available: Gold, Green, Poppy, and Pewter. The soft-look, buttoned upholstery is color coordinated, as are the draperies, valances, and plush shag carpeting.

The dinette area is the place to enjoy meals in quiet comfort. The rich, heirloom mahogany wood table

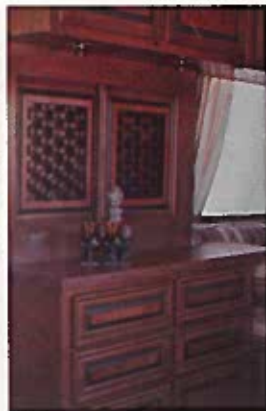
features recessed coasters. And the dinette converts to a double bed. For increased seating comfort, the side-facing gaucho comes complete with bolster and accent pillows. It converts easily to a second, full-size double bed.

All draperies are designed to filter out harsh light. And, for privacy's sake, draperies separate the living area from the cockpit.

Birchaven's standard kitchen features will amaze and delight the chef in your family. The efficient 4-burner range has a full-size glass oven door and range cover. There's



a roomy 6-cubic foot refrigerator with freezer. And the stainless steel, double-bowl sink is fitted with laminated covers, which serve as cutting boards as well as serving trays. The dark-toned, butcher block counters are practical as well as



beautiful. And there's even a handy storage hutch for glasses and bottles.

The rich, mahogany-stained wood cabinets feature easy-touch latches and, for added strength, all drawers are of dove-tailed

construction with glued joints.

Birchaven's roomy rear bath is completely color-coordinated in gold tones and features a step-tub with shower and lavatory. Opposite the tub-shower arrangement is a large, cedar lined double-door

wardrobe with ample storage space.

In all, Birchaven is everything we think a second home should be.

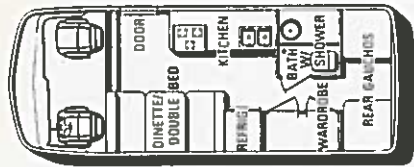

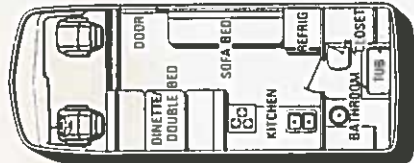

THE MOTOR HOME FROM GENERAL MOTORS

A lot of innovative thinking goes into our basic GMC MotorHome design. Consider our chassis, for instance. Front-wheel drive eliminates the need for the driveshaft and rear axle. An important point because that allows for a low floor and generous interior ceiling height of six feet, four inches. It means ground clearance is ample and the center of gravity is nice and low for good handling response.

You'll also find tandem, not dual, rear wheels. Suspended on air rather than stiff steel springs. The design offers both a wide stance and smooth, stable ride. As a bonus, the rear wheels don't interfere with passenger space.

More worthwhile facts about our suspension system: The air springs are located between each pair of rear wheels to absorb shock. An automatic leveling valve keeps the rear suspension at the desired height under varying load conditions. And the front suspension is torsion bar sprung with stabilizer bars.

The MotorHome body is composed of a cage of aluminum ribs and stringers. The same principle used in jet airplane design. This substructure is then covered with outer skin panels. The lower, front, and rear sections are tough, molded fiberglass for a fine surface finish. Aluminum is used on roof and upper side panels for lightness and corrosion resistance.

We've also worked to reduce extremes of heat, cold, and noise inside your motorhome. Comfortable, even temperatures and quiet result from thick foam insulation.

Crestmont and Birchaven, like all GMC MotorHomes, are built according to our basic plan: dependable motorhomes.
